Legal Basis for Processing

In accordance with sections 29 & 30 of the Localism Act 2011, the Monitoring Officer is required to establish and maintain a register of interests, to ensure that it is available for inspection and that it is published on the authority's website, and you are required to notify the Monitoring Officer of the information in sections 1 to 7 of this form.
